QUESTION 1

SINGLE CHOICE

Which of the following best describes the recommended operating system state before launching the CFPC remote proctoring compatibility check?

- ☐ A A computer with multiple background applications running to simulate real test conditions
- ☒ B A computer with administrator-level access and any background applications disabled
- ☐ C A computer running in safe mode to limit software interference
- ☐ D A computer connected only via mobile hotspot with VPN disabled

ANSWER B

WHY The compatibility check assumes the candidate will test under realistic but controlled conditions: an administrator account (needed to grant the proctoring software the permissions it requires) and no competing background processes that could interfere with screen sharing, the webcam stream, or the microphone check.

QUESTION 2

SINGLE CHOICE

During the audio check, the microphone indicator shows red and no level is registered even though the system recognises the device. What is the most appropriate next step?

- ☐ A Submit the ticket as a hardware failure and stop the check
- ☒ B Verify that the microphone is not muted in the operating system and that the correct input device is selected within the compatibility check interface
- ☐ C Unplug the webcam to free USB bandwidth for the microphone
- ☐ D Reinstall the operating system's audio driver and re-run the check from scratch

ANSWER B

WHY A recognised device that registers no level is almost always muted at the OS level or pointed at the wrong input inside the compatibility tool itself. Re-checking the OS mute state and the device selected in the proctoring tool is the documented remediation before any deeper troubleshooting.

QUESTION 3

SINGLE CHOICE

Which minimum sustained bandwidth is typically required for a stable CFPC remote-proctored session?

- ☐ A 256 kbps upload and download
- ☒ B 1.5 Mbps upload and download
- ☐ C 10 Mbps upload and download
- ☐ D 50 Mbps upload and download

ANSWER B

WHY The session needs to carry a live webcam stream, microphone audio and screen sharing simultaneously in both directions. Roughly 1.5 Mbps up and down is the threshold the CFPC compatibility tool checks for; anything lower tends to introduce frame drops and audio artefacts during the proctored exam.

QUESTION 4

SINGLE CHOICE

Which room setup is acceptable for the CFPC remote-proctored exam environment check?

- ☐ A A shared open-plan office with other staff seated nearby, as long as they are not speaking
- ☒ B A private, quiet room with a closed door, desk cleared of unauthorised materials, and lighting that clearly shows the candidate's face
- ☐ C A bedroom with the candidate seated on the bed and a monitor on a nightstand
- ☐ D A library study room with books visible on the desk but no other person present

ANSWER B

WHY The proctor must be able to see the candidate clearly and confirm no one else is present. A private, closed-door room with a clear desk and good frontal lighting satisfies those checks; shared spaces, beds, and any visible reference material do not.

QUESTION 5

SINGLE CHOICE

According to the CFPC remote-proctoring rules reviewed in the compatibility check, which of the following actions by the candidate would constitute a violation during the live exam?

- ☐ A Taking a brief sip of water from a clear container
- ☐ B Looking away from the screen to think, provided the webcam still captures the face
- ☒ C Reading the question aloud while reasoning through it
- ☐ D Adjusting the webcam angle once at the start of the session

ANSWER C

WHY Reading questions aloud is flagged as a potential proxy-presence indicator and is not permitted; the rules allow brief visual breaks, an initial camera adjustment, and a clear water container, but vocalising exam content is treated as a rule breach.

QUESTION 6

SINGLE CHOICE

The compatibility check reports that the proctoring service cannot be reached even though other websites load normally. Which is the most likely cause and remediation?

- ☐ A The DNS server is offline; switch to a public DNS such as 1.1.1.1
- ☒ B A corporate firewall or endpoint protection product is blocking the proctoring ports or domains; temporarily allow the published proctoring endpoints or run the check on a non-corporate network
- ☐ C The webcam driver is incompatible; update the webcam driver
- ☐ D The monitor refresh rate is too high; lower it to 60 Hz

ANSWER B

WHY General web browsing works but the proctoring endpoints are unreachable is the classic signature of an egress filter blocking specific ports or domains. Allowing the documented proctoring endpoints or moving to a less-restricted network is the documented remediation.

QUESTION 7

SINGLE CHOICE

Which browser configuration is required to successfully complete the CFPC remote proctoring compatibility check?

- ☐ A Any browser with private/incognito mode enabled
- ☒ B A supported browser with cookies, JavaScript and pop-ups enabled for the proctoring site
- ☐ C An outdated browser to mimic the actual exam-day conditions
- ☐ D A mobile browser running on a tablet tethered to the candidate's phone

ANSWER B

WHY The compatibility check itself runs inside the browser; it needs cookies to maintain the session, JavaScript to drive the webcam/mic checks, and pop-ups to launch the proctoring launcher. Private mode and mobile browsers are not supported.

QUESTION 8

TRUE FALSE

A candidate may begin the CFPC remote-proctored exam at any time within the 24-hour window after launching the compatibility check, provided all systems show Pass.

- ☐ A True
- ☒ B False

ANSWER B

WHY False. The compatibility check is a pre-flight diagnostic intended to be completed well in advance of the scheduled exam start time. The exam itself must be launched at the scheduled appointment time; the compatibility check does not open a 24-hour free-start window.

QUESTION 9

MULTIPLE CHOICE

Which of the following items must be cleared from the desk area before the remote proctoring compatibility check begins? (Choose two.)

- ☒ **A** A coffee mug placed near the keyboard
- ☐ **B** A single blank notepad permitted by the exam rules
- ☒ **C** Loose papers and sticky notes not approved by the proctoring policy
- ☐ **D** A closed water bottle with a screw-top lid
- ☐ **E** An external monitor that is part of the approved workstation setup

ANSWER **A - C**

WHY The remote proctoring environment scan requires the desk to be free of items that are not explicitly approved. A coffee mug is not an approved item and must be removed. Loose papers and sticky notes that have not been pre-authorized by the proctoring rules are likewise not allowed on the desk surface during the scan. A blank notepad permitted by the exam rules, a closed water bottle with a screw-top lid, and an external monitor that is part of the approved workstation are all allowed under the standard environment rules.
