WHY IT infrastructure is built on hardware (servers, workstations, network gear) and software (operating systems, applications, firmware). Personal wallpaper preferences and office furniture are not infrastructure components.

ANSWER A • B

WHY IaaS, PaaS, and SaaS are the three widely accepted cloud service models. While SaaS is also legitimate, this question asks for two; 'Furniture as a Service' is not a recognized cloud service model.

WHY The CIA triad is a foundational model in information security representing Confidentiality, Integrity, and Availability of data and systems.

ANSWER A

WHY An operating system's core role is to manage hardware and software resources, including the CPU, memory, storage, and peripheral devices. The other options describe business activities unrelated to OS functions.

ANSWER C

WHY A differential backup copies all data that has changed since the last full backup, growing in size each day until another full backup is taken. An incremental backup only copies data changed since the last backup of any type.

ANSWER B

WHY A network is a group of interconnected devices that share resources and exchange data. A database stores structured data, an algorithm is a step-by-step procedure, and a compiler translates source code.

Which type of malicious software is designed to appear legitimate but performs unwanted actions when executed, often disguised as a useful program?

ANSWER B

WHY A Trojan horse disguises itself as legitimate or useful software to trick users into installing it. Worms self-replicate across networks, rootkits hide deep system access, and spyware covertly collects information.

ANSWER C
