ANSWER A

WHY A kitten is a baby cat, just as a puppy is a baby dog.

WHY Plants need water to grow, so Maya waters the seed so it can sprout and become a plant.

ANSWER C

WHY 'Sad' is the opposite of 'happy'. Glad, joyful, and excited are all synonyms of happy.

ANSWER C

WHY $6 + 7 = 13$.

QUESTION 7

ANSWER B

WHY 'Large' is a synonym for 'big'. Tiny and short mean small, and fast means quick.

ANSWER A

WHY The prefix 'tri-' means three, so a triangle has 3 sides.

- ☒ D Rabbit

ANSWER B - D

WHY Tiger and rabbit are animals. An apple is a fruit and a chair is a piece of furniture.

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
