QUESTION 1

SINGLE CHOICE

A customer wants to deploy Microsoft server software across on-premises servers and Azure virtual machines under a single agreement. Which licensing model allows license mobility between authorized servers and Azure, with Software Assurance as a prerequisite?

ANSWER B

WHY License Mobility through Software Assurance is the Microsoft program that allows customers to reassign server licenses to authorized shared servers, including Azure, provided the licenses are covered by active Software Assurance. Open License, MPSA, and Select Plus are purchasing agreements, not license mobility programs.

QUESTION 2

SINGLE CHOICE

Which Software Assurance benefit allows customers to spread payments for licensed Microsoft software over a multi-year period rather than paying all upfront?

- ☐ A Training Vouchers
- ☒ B Spread Payments
- ☐ C Step-Up Licensing

ANSWER B

WHY Spread Payments is a Software Assurance benefit that lets customers pay for licenses annually rather than all at once, spreading the cost across the agreement term. Training Vouchers, Step-Up Licensing, and New Version Rights are distinct SA benefits that do not relate to payment scheduling.

QUESTION 3

SINGLE CHOICE

Under the Microsoft Software License Terms for Windows 10/11 Pro, what is the maximum number of permitted simultaneous users on a device that has been upgraded with a Windows Pro Education license?

- ☐ **D** Unlimited users

ANSWER A

WHY Windows Pro Education, like Windows Pro, is licensed per device and permits only one (1) user to use the device at a time under the standard license terms. The 2-user or 5-user figures sometimes seen apply to certain OEM or volume scenarios but not the standard Pro/Pro Education device license.

QUESTION 4

SINGLE CHOICE

An organization has 1,000 users that each require Windows Server, Exchange Server, SharePoint, and Skype for Business (now Teams) CAL functionality. What is the minimum number of Core CAL Suite licenses that must be acquired to cover these users?

- ☐ **A** 250
- ☐ **B** 500

- ☐ **D** 4,000

ANSWER C

WHY Core CAL Suite is licensed per user (or per device), and each user needs their own CAL Suite to access the covered server software. With 1,000 users needing access to all the included workloads, 1,000 Core CAL Suite licenses are required.

QUESTION 5

SINGLE CHOICE

An organization subscribes to Microsoft 365 Business Premium for 50 users. Under the licensing terms, what is the maximum number of devices on which each licensed user may install the Office desktop applications?

- ☐ B 2 devices

- ☐ D Unlimited devices

ANSWER C

WHY Microsoft 365 Business Premium, like most Microsoft 365/Office 365 plans, allows each licensed user to install the Office desktop apps on up to five (5) devices (PCs or Macs) and up to five tablets. The single-device limit applies to Office Home and Business, not to Microsoft 365 plans.

QUESTION 6

SINGLE CHOICE

Which Microsoft volume licensing agreement is designed for organizations with 250 or more users or devices and uses a single organization-wide commitment for the entire enrollment term?

- ☐ A Microsoft Products and Services Agreement (MPSA)
- ☒ B Enterprise Agreement (EA)
- ☐ C Open License
- ☐ D Microsoft Customer Agreement (MCA)

ANSWER B

WHY The Enterprise Agreement is intended for organizations with 250+ users/devices and operates on a single organization-wide enrollment commitment, typically a 3-year term. MPSA is transactional, Open License was discontinued for new purchases, and MCA is Microsoft Commerce's direct-cloud purchasing agreement.

QUESTION 7

SINGLE CHOICE

A customer wants to license Windows Server 2022 Standard for use on a physical server with two processors and run up to two Windows Server virtual machines on it. What is the minimum licensing requirement?

- ☐ A 1 Windows Server Standard core license covering all cores
- ☒ B 8 core licenses (minimum) plus 1 Standard license for the second VM

ANSWER B

WHY Windows Server 2022 Standard is licensed by physical core with a minimum of 8 core licenses per server and a minimum of 8 cores per processor. Each Standard license grants the right to run one instance of the server software (OS or VM) on the licensed server; running two VMs therefore requires a second Standard license in addition to the required core licenses.

When licensing Windows Server on an Azure D-series virtual machine (which has a vCPU-to-core ratio of 1:1), how many vCPUs are required to satisfy the minimum core license requirement?

ANSWER C

WHY For Azure D-series VMs, the vCPU-to-core ratio is 1:1. Because Windows Server Standard/Datacenter licensing requires a minimum of 8 core licenses per VM, the customer must license at least 8 vCPUs on a D-series VM to meet the minimum.

Which Microsoft volume licensing agreement is structured as a three-year commitment, uses a single enrollment for the entire organization, and is designed for organizations with 250 or more users or devices that want to license software across multiple affiliates?

ANSWER C

WHY The Enterprise Agreement (EA) is Microsoft's volume licensing program designed for organizations with 250 or more users or devices, uses a single enrollment to cover the entire organization (with the option to extend coverage to affiliated companies), and is built around a three-year commitment that provides price stability and the option to true-up annually.
