WHY Go (often called Golang) is an open-source, statically typed, compiled language developed at Google. It compiles directly to native machine code (no VM) and includes first-class concurrency primitives such as goroutines and channels.

ANSWER A

WHY Go source files use the .go extension, for example hello.go. The other extensions are not used by the official Go toolchain.

ANSWER B

ANSWER A

WHY Go uses var for explicit declarations, including short forms where the type is inferred from the right-hand side, for example `x := 5`. Go does not use let, def, or auto.
