Under Utah law, what is the minimum age at which an individual may be issued a resident insurance producer license?

ANSWER B

WHY Utah Code §31A-23-204 requires an applicant for a resident producer license to be at least 18 years of age. The other ages listed are not the statutory minimum.

What is the standard length of the initial term for a Utah resident insurance producer license before renewal is required?

ANSWER B

WHY Under Utah law, a non-resident or resident producer license is issued for a two-year license period, after which it must be renewed.

- ☐ A 12 hours, including 2 hours of ethics

ANSWER C

WHY Utah requires resident producers to complete 24 hours of continuing education per two-year license period, which must include 3 hours of ethics training approved by the department.

Which of the following acts by an insurance producer would most clearly constitute an unfair practice under Utah's Unfair Practices in the Insurance Business provisions?

ANSWER C

WHY Rebating is prohibited as an unfair practice in Utah. The other activities described are routine and appropriate producer duties.

ANSWER A • C

WHY Utah requires the applicant to be at least 18 years old and to pass the required licensing examination. Utah residency of any specific duration is not required for a resident license, and the appointment by an insurer occurs separately after licensure.

ANSWER A

WHY The Insurance Department may suspend, revoke, or place on probation a producer's license as a disciplinary action. The Department does not set commissions, determine premium rates, or cancel insurers' certificates of authority.

Which of the following are considered unfair or deceptive practices under Utah's Unfair Practices in the Insurance Business Act? (Choose two.)

- ☒ **C** Knowingly making false statements about the financial condition of an insurer

ANSWER A • C

WHY Misrepresenting policy terms and benefits, and making false statements about an insurer's financial condition, are unfair or deceptive practices. Timely policy delivery and required filings are routine compliance activities, not unfair practices.

ANSWER B

WHY The Utah Insurance Department is the state agency charged with regulating the business of insurance in Utah, including both insurers and producers.

When must an insurance producer notify the Utah Insurance Department of a change in the producer's residential or business address?

- ☐ A Only at the time of license renewal
- ☐ B Within 10 days of the change

ANSWER C

WHY Utah producers are required to report a change of address to the Department within 30 days. Failure to do so may result in administrative action against the license.
